About ten years later we had our first Block Party. It consisted of the Rockin' Hollywoods in front of the bank after the Wheels, Wings and Water Parade. We served about 300 hot dogs. It was considered a "bold marketing move" by other local banks. Today the Block Party has over 10,000 spectators and we host acts that have sold millions of records and won Grammy awards.

The bank has grown too. Today there are six locations, modern technology such as on line banking, and a number of new services including Liberty Insurance and Residential Title. Our customer base has grown as well. From perhaps a thousand customers when I started to over 30,000 unique customers today. We service three quarter of a billion dollars in home loans in Central Minnesota. And we have managed to remain successful through some very tough times in our industry and the economy.

I've said it before and I'll keep saying it until I retire. The true measure of the value of a bank is the quality of its customers. And that makes Liberty a very valuable financial institution.

Thank you for being a customer. We will continue to work very hard to provide you with the best banking experience possible. Happy New Year and have a great 2013.



COUNTING THE CASH!

Liberty again volunteers to count the cash for the Salvation Army Kettle Campaign





For many years Liberty has sorted and counted all of the cash that is collected by the Salvation Army Kettle

When you see one of those bell ringers we promise you this: You throw in your dimes, quarters and dollars and we will cheerfully count and sort it!



ATM and Debit Card Safety

ATM and debit cards provide a fast and easy way to get cash, make purchases and conduct a variety of account transactions. Protecting your card should become a priority. There are several ways you can protect your card.

Watch for skimming devices:

Skimming devices are devices added



to a terminal to capture your card and PIN data. Skimming devices can be placed on card readers, ATM's, point-of-sale terminals such as gas pumps. If you suspect that a terminal has been tampered with or has been altered, do not complete your transaction.

Keep your PIN to yourself: No one ever needs to know your PIN number, not even your bank. Memorize your PIN and never write it on your card, or store it with your card. Never let someone else enter your PIN number for you.

Shop carefully online: When you initiate an online transaction, look for indicators that the site is secure, such as "https" in the web address or the closed padlock icon. Also do not conduct online financial transactions using pubic wireless internet, they can be more vulnerable to attack.

Report a lost or stolen card immediately: If your card is lost or stolen card your bank immediately. This will help reduce the chance that the card will be used improperly. This step will also limit your potential liability for unauthorized transactions.

Review your account statement regularly: Verify your transactions by matching your receipts to your account statements. Also, check your account using online banking on a regular basis to verify that all transactions have been authorized by you.

Never respond to an unsolicited request: Never provide your debit card number or PIN number or any other private information to anyone in response to an unsolicited email, pop-up message, or phone request. Your bank with never ask for your PIN number.

Be Safe At the ATM: Beware of phony ATM machines, try to always use an ATM you are familiar with. Observe your surroundings before you use an ATM. Be sure the ATM is in a well-lit area, and minimize the time you spend at the ATM by completing your transaction quickly. It is also good practice to block the view of the keypad to prevent "shoulder surfing" from patrons waiting in line to use the ATM. Also, remember that you will only be asked once to enter your PIN number, if you are asked more than one time, cancel the transaction and use another ATM.

Using these simple precautionary tips will help protect your card. Please contact any of our Customer Service Representatives with questions.

- Check your bank statement often
- Don't give your PIN number to anyone, don't write it down,
- Consider using a credit card for online purchase
- Don't use public wireless internet for financial transactions
- Report your lost or stolen debit card immediately
- Report problems immediately
