
Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP)

Understanding the program.

The St. Cloud Housing and Redevelopment Authority has worked closely with Stearns, Benton and Sherburne counties to secure funding for neighborhoods in our region which have experienced high rates of foreclosure. The HRA has secured \$2.5 million in funds that can be used by potential home buyers to acquire and remodel homes in select neighborhoods.

There are 14 targeted neighborhoods. Maps of the eligible neighborhoods can be viewed at the St. Cloud HRA's website at www.stcloudhra.com. Individuals interested in using this program will need to meet the requirements of qualifying for a mortgage, meeting any income requirements of the program and attending home buyer education classes.

The funds will be available to purchase and rehabilitate properties that have gone through foreclosure and are now owned by the lender. There is up to \$14,000 of down payment assistance available with this program. A review of the property is completed by the St. Cloud HRA to determine what types of rehabilitation the property may need. Liberty Savings Bank employee TSgt. James "Jamie" Emery is leaving for his third tour of duty. We are proud of him and his accomplishments and wish him the best of luck.

Jamie graduated from Buffalo High School in 1996. He started his college career at the University of North Dakota and finished at Minnesota State University in Mankato with a degree in finance. Jamie started working for Liberty Savings Bank in March 2008.

Jamie joined the Air National Guard (Air Force) in 1999 as a way to help pay for college and serve his country following in his grandfather's footsteps.

Jamie's duties as a combat weather forecaster consist of providing weather details during briefings to helicopter pilots and unit commanders to use for various mission planning purposes, the protection of millions of dollars of equipment and the safety of thousands of troops. He is the eyes forward for the Air Force weather forecasters in the states who put together the forecasts for overseas troops. He is also responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of various weather equipment and sensors that are located at other bases.

In February 2003, after training in Lackland AFB, in San Antonio, Texas; Keesler AFB in Biloxi, Mississippi; and Grand Forks AFB in Grand Forks, North Dakota, he was called up in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom on active duty between Fort Polk in Leesville, Louisiana and Redcatcher Army Airfield on Camp Muleskinner, which is just on the outskirts of Baghdad, Iraq.

Jamie graduated from college in 2006 and volunteered for 6 months of duty in support of Operation Enduring Freedom at various locations around Northeastern Afghanistan as the Non-Commissioned Officer in charge (team leader) of the combat weather team for that area.

Jamie came back in the summer of 2007 and then volunteered for 3 months of backfill support duty at the base weather station at Fort Wainwright, in Fairbanks, Alaska.

His third tour to the Middle East will start in August 2009 and will last 6 months. Jamie will be the Non-Commissioned Officer in charge (team leader) of the combat weather team stationed in the Basra, Iraq area. When Jamie returns from Iraq he will prepare for his wedding in June 2010.

Founder of The Byrds and Rock and Roll Hall of Famer to perform at Paramount September 25th!

Mr. Tambourine Man, Turn! Turn! Turn!, So You Want to be a Rock And Roll Star...those songs and that beautiful jangly 12-string guitar are unforgettable sounds of our musical history. Liberty Savings Bank is sponsoring Roger McGuinn's appearance at the Paramount Theatre on September 25th. It is sure to create even more musical memories.

Mr. McGuinn began his musical career playing right out of high school with folk groups like the Chad Mitchell Trio, Limelighters and others. He also backed Bobby Darin and even co-wrote some songs for him. Then in 1965, Roger McGuinn, Chris Hillman, Gene Clark and David Crosby (later of Crosby Stills and Nash) founded the Byrds and made musical history. They enjoyed many huge hits and McGuinn was a huge influence on contemporary music. First he



pioneered folk rock, later introducing space age rock with the use of electronics. One of The Byrds greatest legacies was the groundbreaking *Sweethearts of the Rodeo* album which introduced contemporary Country Rock. The Byrds and Roger McGuinn were early inductees into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 2001. Mr. McGuinn has recently been very active as a solo artist furthering the appreciation for contemporary folk music.

Liberty will have 150 pairs of tickets to give away for this exciting event. They will be distributed first come, first serve, two to a person on Friday, September 4, 2009 at our Waite Park location beginning at 8:00 a.m.
